



Youth in Action: “Discuss, understand ... change, environment” LITTLE GREEN FILM AWARD

Objectives

1. To get youth to pay more attention to the environmental issues such as the importance of trees, forests, way of living and the future of the environment.
2. To encourage youth to engage with the media.
3. To publicize and promote the youth exchange activities under the Youth in Action Program which is operating in 4 countries, Slovenia, Lithuania, Thailand and China.
4. To select youth representatives from 4 operating countries to be involved in the Youth in Action program activities which will be hosted in China (Youth in Action: China, 29th August – 5 September 2013).
5. To publicize the campaign produced through media such through media as television, radio, publication and internet.

Rules and Regulations

3. Eligibility

- Thai, Slovenian, Lithuanian or Chinese national
- Age between 16 – 23 years old

4. Entry process

- Applicant can apply in the team of 1 to 3 people

All the details must be filled in.

- The document of each team member required with the application form:
 - Copy of identification cards with the signatures

5. Submission process

- You need to submit:
 - 1) Your application form
 - 2) Your one minute film
- The submission is via E-mail only. This can be done only by uploading your film to YouTube, then attach the link together with your film summary and the



scanned copy of you ID and send them to kratkifilmdrevo@gmail.com before midnight of the 16th of March 2013.

6. Entry requirements

- The film must be exactly 60 seconds in total running time, including titles and credits
- Submission can be made individually or as a team (1-3 persons). If you submit as a team, you must specify one team representative that would be joining the activity hosted in China between 29th of August – 5th of September 2013.
- The Little Green Film Award is opened to all categories of film i.e. documentary, news animation, music video or drama etc.
- English subtitle is required and must be included for every non-English works and script.
- All films must be original work of the applicants. It must not infringe upon any copyrights, trademarks, rights of privacy, publicity, intellectual property or other rights of any person or entity.
- Any pictures, songs, music or items that have copyrights must be sited/given credit to.
- Film submitted to prior festivals/competitions will not be eligible for Little Green Film Award.
- Little Green Film committee will reserve the rights to reject any entry at its own discretion.
- By participating in this competition, entrants agree that during the competition period, Little Green Film and its sponsors and partners are authorized to display the films on the Little Green Film site and on any and all other media in connection with the competition.
- The judging committee decision is the ultimate decision.

7. Judging

- **Best of Little Green**

1) Creativity	40%
2) Subject matter	30%
3) Production quality (editing techniques)	20%
4) Public voting	10%

- **Popular vote award**

The voting result is according to the number of views of particular video in Youtube and the number of 'likes'.

8. Exposure and announcement

- All eligible films will be posted for public viewing on Little Green Film official site, Facebook, and other affiliated sites.
- Announcement of shortlist (10 from each country) will be made on Little Green Film official site, Facebook, and other affiliated sites (please check with your country's organizer) on 20th March 2013
- All shortlisted films will be shown at Suan Dusit Place hotel, Bangkok, Thailand on 29th March 2013

- 16 March 2013 Midnight submissions close
- 20 March 2013 Shortlisted films announcement
- 20–28 March 2013 Jury selection and public voting
- 29 March 2013 Announce Little Green Film award

10. Awards

 - 1) The winner will be granted as one of the representatives of youth to participate in the “Youth in Action: Discuss, understand, change... environment!” project at Beijing, People’s Republic of China from 29th August to 5th September 2013.
 - 2) Trophies and certificates
- **9 commendations**
- **Popular vote**
 - 1) One 10,000-baht Samsung Galaxy tab (or equivalent)
 - 2) Certificates

In case that he or she receives more than one award, the committee will consider granting only the highest one.
